RONILAN PHASE OUT

BASF Canada is phasing out the use of RONILAN® fungicide in the Canadian marketplace.

The decision to phase out RONILAN is based on a number of factors including:

- a decision by BASF (Global) to close the only production facility that manufactures the raw materials required for the production of RONILAN;
- consideration of existing use patterns of RONILAN in Canada; and
- BASF has new generation fungicide products in the marketplace that provide superior control of key diseases in the same crops.

BASF and the PMRA have agreed to the following phase out schedule from the Canadian market:

- 2008 will be the last year that RONILAN is sold by BASF in Canada; and
- 2010 (up until December 31, 2010) will be the last year that RONILAN is available for application for any registered use by producers in Canada
